- Active participation in set-up and take down of all events is highly appreciated.
- Supporting our communication by participating on social media channels, events, and promoting our association.
- While HIP members may be your biggest fans, this is not a sales platform. You can share news and make special offers, but repeated attempts at selling your products or services are not allowed.

Membership

The heart of the association is the members: HIP succeeds thanks to our members' engagement – it is not a product for consumption but a space for interaction, sharing and co-creating.

Membership is open to all women who share the HIP mission and values and who want to support the purpose of the association.

Besides our events we will have annual members' meetings where we discuss the current status of the association, our activities, new ideas for development and the members' needs and expectations.

To become a member, go to the HIP website and fill in the 'join HIP' form. We will get back to you within a week with further information.

Our fiscal year starts in January. There is an annual membership fee of 60 € to be paid at January 1st. This fee covers the entrance to most of our events, workshops and seminars. Exceptions may occur for certain events, for instance when external speakers are invited.

Membership can be terminated in writing to the Steering Committee at the latest one month prior to the end of the fiscal year (December 31). There will be no reimbursement of membership fees.

Membership may also be terminated by the Steering Committee in case of incompatibility with our vision, mission and the Association Guidelines.

The HIP Steering Committee

The Steering Committee is the Executive team that manages the association and represents it externally.

The HIP Steering Committee consists of 5 members. Three of the members are elected and registered at court. Two additional members are not registered but share equal authority within the Steering Committee. Elections will be held every three years during a general assembly.

The Steering Committee should be made up of diverse nationalities, with no single nationality having more than 2 members on the committee.
